What is happening?	When is it happening?
Welcome to Hazeley Tour and key staff	Tuesday 18th March 2025 Parents and students can join us for an opportunity to tour the academy, with a brief introduction from the Year 7 Team. 4pm - 5.15pm
Visits to Primary Schools	June 2025 onwards Hazeley Academy staff will visit your child in their primary school to talk about what it is like to belong to the Hazeley Academy and to answer any questions they may have prior to Transition Day.
Excellence Transition	Tuesday 17th June 2025 – SEND Transition Day For students with identified SEND needs to attend the school during the day and meet our SEND team. 9am - 3pm. In addition, our Excellence team will work with families, identified through their work with primary schools, to provide additional transition experience. This will support those students with the highest levels of SEND.
Fewer than 5 event	Wednesday 25th June 2025 Afterschool event 3.45pm – 5.15pm for those students and their parents who are coming from a school with fewer than 5 other students. Invitations will be sent to you.
Transition Day	Monday 7th July 2025 Students will attend the Academy for the school day, and there will be a transition event in the evening for parents.
Parent and Carer's coffee mornings	Thursday 10th July 2025 Drop in between 8.40-10am for a coffee and an opportunity for parents to meet staff and ask any questions. This is often a good follow-up to the transition evening if parents have further questions or queries.
Hazeley Fest	Friday 11th July 2025 – Hazeley Fest 5pm onwards Activities after school with an overnight sleepover with the aim of having fun and mixing with new students in a relaxed and social way.

New Starter Day	Wednesday 3rd September 2025 The first day for our new Year 7s. It is a full school day and students should arrive at the Academy by 8.35am and will finish at 3.15 pm.
Welcome to the Year Ahead	September 2025 (Date TBC) An opportunity to meet with your child's form tutor to see how the first few weeks have gone and to be informed about the year ahead.
